

## **Label Printing with a Macintosh**

### **Situation:**

The art department of a large company needed to design and print product labels with various logos and bar codes. The employees preferred printing all labels directly from their Macintosh computers, which they use to design the artwork and label layout.

### **Solution:**

The company purchased Tharo H-Series label printers, which include free Macintosh CUPS drivers designed for Macintosh computers. The Tharo CUPS driver was installed using the standard Mac OS installation assistant and integrated seamlessly with the Macintosh graphics software. All artwork and label design was created in house and the required bar code fonts were purchased online. The company is now able to design and print labels directly from their Macintosh computer and does not have to use a Windows PC.
